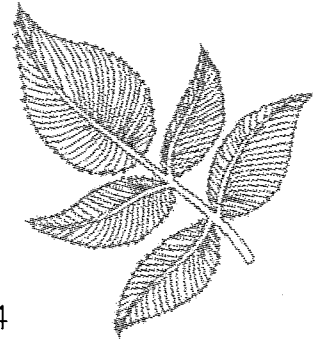

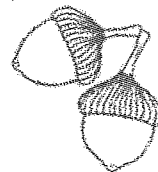


SESSION NOTES - September 10, 2010

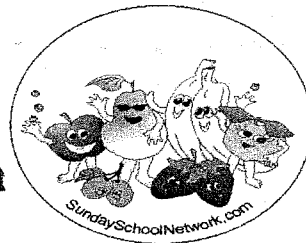
